NSF would like to engage a Chess Sport Director (CSD) in a part-time role, with responsibility for the national chess teams (Open, Women), and for the various development teams within NSF.

The CSD will assume the responsibility for player contracts, planning and training, nominations and tournament participation. Long-term goals, annual actions plans and budgets will be decided in close liaison with an advisory group, to be nominated by the NSF board.

The national teams and development teams are each to have their individual responsible leaders, who in turn will report to the CSD. These leaders will be appointed by NSF separately, in close dialogue with the CSD. A separate players' representatives council will link the CSD to the players' community e.g. during the nomination processes.

NSF is looking for an individual with strong chess acumen and background, fair knowledge of the Norwegian chess community, excellent leadership skills, and a strong desire to participate in bringing Norwegian top chess to the next level. The CSD will be engaged in a fixed term 2 year contract. Remuneration, hours and other contractual issues to be mutually decided.
